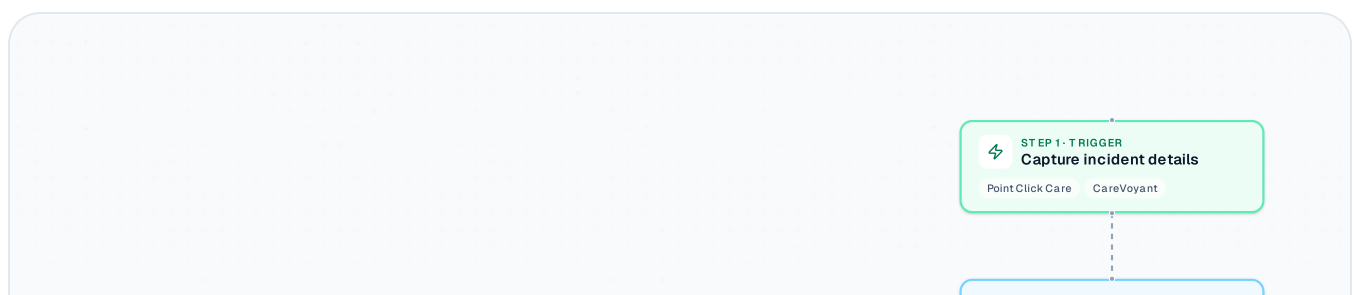


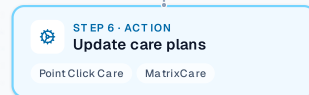
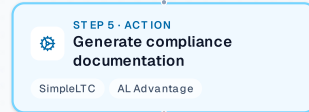
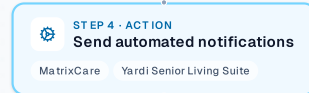
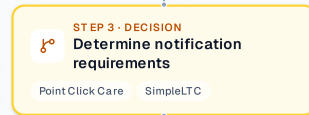
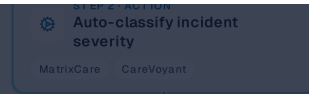
WORKFLOW TRIGGER

Staff member submits incident report form or sensor detects fall/emergency event

Visual Flow

Each node represents an automated step. Connections show how data and decisions move through the workflow.





Step-by-Step Breakdown

Detailed explanation of each automated stage in the workflow.

⚡ TRIGGER

Capture incident details

Staff submits incident report through mobile app or automated sensors detect emergency events like falls. Initial incident data including time, location, resident involved, and basic details are captured.

 ACTION

Auto-classify incident severity

AI system analyzes incident details and automatically categorizes severity level and type (fall, medication error, behavioral, etc.). System flags high-priority incidents requiring immediate attention.

 DECISION

Determine notification requirements

System evaluates incident severity and type to determine if immediate family notification, physician contact, or regulatory reporting is required. Routes workflow based on compliance requirements.
